The evaluation included an audit of the core activities, operation, human resources, infrastructure and quality assurance system of the institution.

As a result of the institutional accreditation audit, the HAC grants accreditation to the University of Debrecen for the period until **31 December 2022**, subject to continuous compliance with the accreditation criteria.

Reasoning:

Based on the site visit and the self-evaluation report submitted, it has been established that the University of Debrecen complies with the criteria for institutional accreditation adopted by the HAC on the basis of the ESG 2015, and its quality assurance system is to the extent stated in the report suitable for ensuring the quality of competence based education in accordance with the ESG 2015.

The University has a strong strategic vision and a well-formulated strategy; the quality of the training provided by the University enables it to fulfil the role undertaken in its mission statement.

Its educational work in the field of organising training and supporting students is carried out in accordance with clearly defined and publicly available rules.

It performs extensive basic and applied research in cooperation with the private sector and strives to continuously exploit research findings in its training programmes.
